**SUMMER TERM NOTIFICATION -2023**

*(For Undergraduate programs in the Schools of Technology, Humanities and Social Sciences, Business, and Science)*

Students can register for the Summer Term 2023 as per the following rules and regulations:

1. Eligibility:
  - a. Candidates having backlogs of **2021-22 AB & 2022-23AB** are eligible to register for the courses offered by paying a re-registration fee of **Rs 10,000/-** per course.
  - b. Candidates whose CGPA is less than 6.5 are eligible to re-register for offered courses conducted during the summer term by paying a re-registration fee of **Rs 10,000/-** for each course. In such cases, the grades obtained in the re-registered courses only will be considered for GPA/CGPA.
2. The eligible candidates can register for a maximum of **4 courses**.
3. The maximum number of courses a candidate can re-register for grade improvement during their study period is limited to the number of semesters of study completed.
4. The summer term 2023 will commence on **1<sup>st</sup> June 2023** and conclude by **28<sup>th</sup> June 2023** through **online mode**.
5. Attendance for each course, during special instruction classes, is mandatory. Candidates must maintain at least **75% attendance** in each course during the summer term classes.
6. Candidates must mandatorily appear for internal assessment during the summer term classes for each course.
7. The term-end examination will be conducted offline and scheduled after **29<sup>th</sup> June 2023 on Saturdays**.
8. The maximum grade for a re-registered course is capped at **B + (Grade cap)**
9. There are **no supplementary examinations** from 2021-22 admitted batches.

**Note:**

- (1) *The course registration date for Summer Term 2023 will be communicated shortly.*
- (2) *Students are advised to take this opportunity and clear any backlogs they may have from the first semester. Clearing the backlogs is a requirement for graduating on time.*
- (3) *Students must complete 80% of the registered credits before proceeding to the final year of study.*
- (4) *For Practical type (P) and Theory + Practical type (TP) courses, practical sessions will be conducted **offline only**. However, LANG1001, LANG1011, LANG1021, CSEN1011 & CSEN1021 courses will be conducted **online during summer term**.*
- (5) *Students are required to attend 15 lab classes @ 2 hours from 03-07-2023, depending on lab availability.*
